HOUSING SIZE		
Adequate for number of birds housed (enough perch space, room to move etc)		
LOCATION		
Sited to stay dry, odor-free, promote comfort and health of birds		
SECURITY		
Not a nuisance to neighbors (smells, noise, views etc)		
Closable coop or coop plus welded-wire fence, buried or flared at base, or with		
landscape netting flared at base, for nighttime roosting		
SANITATION		
Coop and pen clean, dry, regular removal of soiled bedding		
FEED AND WATER		
Fresh, nutritionally complete, access to water at all times		
HEALTHCARE		
Veterinary care and preventive medical care provided to prevent the spread of		
disease and mitigate suffering		
BIOSECURITY		
Owners aware of the potential for disease transmission		
Owners agree to report any bird death or illness just prior, during, or within 21 days after Tour		
ENRICHMENT		
Birds have access to outdoor areas to dust-bathe and scratch		
Owners strive to provide enriching activities (varied diet, free-range etc.)		
AESTHETICS	1	
Located geographically to suit the needs of the Tour		
Coops, pens and surrounding structures in good repair		
Exhibits beauty, creativity or something of interest to Tour visitors		
Complies with all applicable animal ordinances		
Safely Accessible to visitors		
Adequate, safe parking areas available near the site on Tour day
